



Concealed Weapons and Carry System

CWC assists county agencies in complying with the Concealed Weapons Statute 571.101 RSMo, enabling citizens to carry concealed weapons. With a certificate of qualification, citizens can go to the Department of Revenue (DOR) to apply for a Concealed Weapons and Carry System endorsement. The CWC interfaces provide immediate access to applicants' drivers license photos and pedigree information.

REJIS is a local government agency created to "serve the public interest through delivering quality, cost-effective technology services to the justice community and to government and quasi-government agencies." REJIS' primary focus is to provide record management services to law enforcement, courts, and corrections agencies at the local, state and federal levels. This includes interfaces to the Missouri State Highway Patrol's MULES system, the National Crime Information Center (NCIC), and the NLETS network. REJIS was founded in 1975 under a cooperative agreement between St. Louis County and the City of St. Louis. Our customers are primarily concentrated in the metropolitan St. Louis and southwestern Illinois areas.

REJIS services include:

- Development of custom applications
- Installation and support of custom and commercially available software
- Custom interfaces
- IT Support Service
- Data center outsourcing
- Network, training and help desk support.

REJIS has approximately 140 employees located at three sites. Most of the staff and equipment is based at the REJIS building, in the Central West End of St. Louis.

Benefits & Features

- **DOR Interface:** Automatically populates the CWC application with applicant's pedigree and driver's license photo from the Department of Revenue to minimize data entry and assist in verifying the applicant's pedigree information via a real time connection. The applicant takes the certificate to a DOR office to obtain a Conceal Carry endorsement.
- **Violations:** Presents a history of any traffic violations from the Department of Revenue.
- **Required Reporting Information Interface:** Allows reporting required information to the Missouri Uniform Law Enforcement System (MULES) and the Department of Revenue.
- **CWC Certificate of Qualification:** Prints the qualification certificate form that is issued to the applicant.
- **Security:** Secure, encrypted web-based system.
- **Ease of Use:** Easy and trouble-free navigation. Simple application status control. Click approve, deny, revoke and renew functions.
- **Support:** 24/7 Password support and issue submission to Help Desk.
- **Management:** Handles all aspects of managing concealed weapon permits, including applications, certification documents, certificate renewals and expirations.
- **Reports:** Produces reports on demand, including
 - Pending Report - Pending applications
 - Approved Report - Approved applications
 - Denied Report - Declined applications
 - Fees Collected Report
- **Optional Features:** Interfaces with REJIS, MULES, and NCIC Wanted Inquiries.
