Convenience for the public, no worries for the Court. Accept on-line payments for traffic tickets and other ordinance violations with this secure web-based payment application. REJIS connects the public to your court for real-time access to the fees and fines assessed by case/ticket number through IMDS (Integrated Metropolitan Docketing System). *The REJIS Commission is a local government agency created to “serve the public interest through delivering quality, cost-effective technology services to the justice community and to government and quasi-government agencies.” REJIS’ primary focus is to provide record management services to law enforcement, courts, and corrections agencies at the local, state and federal levels. This includes interfaces to the Missouri State Highway Patrol’s MULES system, the National Crime Information Center (NCIC), and the NLETS network. REJIS was founded in 1975 under a cooperative agreement between St. Louis County and the City of St. Louis. Our customers are primarily concentrated in the metropolitan St. Louis and southwestern Illinois areas.*
