The agency requests access to GA Net, whose purpose is to promote efficient government operations. This service will give the agency access to a variety of computerized records.

The agency understands that it will be charged according to the price schedule and will be billed monthly. Payment is due upon receipt of the invoice.

REJIS' role is limited to providing the technical resources necessary to support the software that REJIS provides. Since the information that comprises the computer record is entered by others, the agency agrees to indemnify and hold REJIS harmless from any claims arising from its use of the computerized information.

The agency is responsible for the use of the Access IDs assigned to it. The agency understands that GA Net information is to be used for the conduct of its public mission and for no other purpose. The resale of this information as a separate product is specifically prohibited. Unless the agency notifies REJIS in writing to cancel an Access ID, it is responsible for the cost of service attributed to the Access ID.

The service is available on a non-guaranteed basis from 12:30 a.m. to 11:30 p.m., 7 days a week. Help Desk services are available Monday through Friday, from 7:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., excluding holidays.

Either REJIS or the agency may cancel this service upon 30 days advance written notice.

Addendum to User Agreement

Missouri Department of Revenue Access:

Missouri law permits applicants for vehicle registration and driver licenses to restrict access to certain personal descriptive information. Once a person makes this declaration, the Missouri Department of Revenue must conceal this information from the general public, and only make it available for certain purposes.

Effective September 13, 1997, use of personal information on operator licenses and vehicle registrations is governed by RSMo 32.055 and Title 18, 2721(b) of the United States Code. The permissible uses are printed on the reverse of this Addendum. The business of your agency appears to qualify for one or more of the permissible uses. Consequently, REJIS will continue to provide access to the full driver/vehicle records, subject to the following conditions:

1. The agency will comply with the limitations specified in its use of the record.
2. The agency will not release the record to any other party contrary to this law.
3. Failure to comply will result in cancellation of access to driver/vehicle records.

Equifax Access (Provided by CSC Credit Services, Inc.):

Equifax provides the Locator Reports to you through REJIS in connection with the following need. Signing the acknowledgement indicates that you will comply with the limitations specified below.

- i. For use as necessary to effect, administer, or enforce a transaction requested or authorized by the consumer.
- ii. For use to protect against or prevent actual or potential fraud, unauthorized transactions, claims, or other liability.
- iii. For use in required institutional risk control programs.
- iv. For use in resolving customer disputes.
- v. For use by persons, or their representatives, holding a legal or beneficial interest relating to the consumer.
- vi. For use by persons acting with the consumer's consent in a fiduciary or representative capacity on behalf of the consumer.
- vii. For use in complying with federal, state, or local laws, rules, and other applicable legal requirements.
- viii. For use in an investigation on a matter related to public safety.

1. A government agency (federal, state or local) or employed by such, and authorized to request vehicle/driving records for the purpose of the government agency's carrying out its functions.
2. A Missouri Circuit, Associate Circuit or Municipal court, an out-of-state court, or employed by such, and authorized to request vehicle/driving records for the purpose of the court's carrying out its functions.
3. A Missouri or out-of-state law enforcement agency or employed by such, and authorized to request vehicle/driving records for the purpose of the law enforcement agency's carrying out its functions.
4. Authorized under the Federal Driver's Privacy Protection Act to request and obtain the vehicle/driving record for use in connection with matters of motor vehicle or driver safety and theft; motor vehicle emissions; motor vehicle product alterations, recalls, or advisories; performance monitoring of motor vehicles, motor vehicle parts and dealers; motor vehicle market research activities, including survey research; and removal of non-owner records from the original owner records of motor vehicle manufacturers.
5. Authorized representative, agent, contractor, or employed by such, of a legitimate business and the vehicle/driving record being requested will be used for normal course of business; but only to:
 - o verify accuracy of the personal information.
 - o obtain correct information but only for purposes of preventing fraud, pursuing legal remedies or collecting a debt.
6. Authorized under the Federal Driver's Privacy Protection Act to request and obtain the vehicle/driving record for use in connection with any civil, criminal, administrative, or arbitral proceeding in any federal, state, or local court or agency or before any self-regulatory body, including the service of process, investigation in anticipation of litigation, and the execution or enforcement of judgments and orders, or pursuant to an order of a federal, state, or local court.
7. Authorized under the Federal Driver's Privacy Protection Act to request and obtain the vehicle/driving record for use in research activities, and producing statistical reports, so long as the personal information is not published, redisclosed, or used to contact individuals.
8. Authorized representative, agent, contractor or employed by such, of an insurer, insurance support organization or self-insured entity and the vehicle/driving record being requested will be used only in connection with the following:
 - o claims investigation activities
 - o antifraud activities
 - o rating or underwriting
9. Authorized under the Federal Driver's Privacy Protection Act to request and obtain the vehicle/driving record for use in providing notice to the owners of towed or impounded vehicles.
10. Authorized representative or owner of a licensed private investigative agency or licensed security service and the vehicle/driving record is being requested for the use of purposes permitted under the Federal Driver's Privacy Protection Act.
11. Authorized as an employer, or its agent or insurer under the Federal Driver's Privacy Protection Act to request and obtain the vehicle/driving record for use in obtaining or verifying information relating to a holder of a commercial driver's license (CDL).
12. Authorized representative or owner of a private toll transportation facility and authorized under the Federal Drivers' Privacy Protection Act to request and obtain the vehicle/driving record for use in the operation of the facility.
13. Authorized under the law of the state that holds the record to request and obtain the vehicle/driving record if the vehicle/driving record will be used in relationship to the operation of the motor vehicle or public safety.
14. Authorized persons who have a purpose to disseminate to the public a newspaper, book, magazine, broadcast or similar form of public communication, including dissemination by computer or other electronic means, when such dissemination is related to the operation of a motor vehicle or to public safety.
